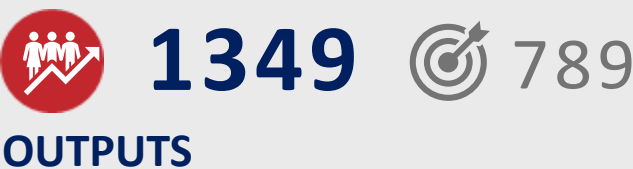

WHO WE REACHED



WHAT WORKED WELL

-  Strong multi-agency partnerships (Adult Social Care, Project Pilot, Job Centre)
-  Simple & accessible referral process
-  Specialist support led to training & jobs
-  Welcoming, person-focused spaces helped participant engagement

WHAT WAS DIFFICULT

-  Staffing gaps affected consistency
-  Too much admin meant Navigators had less time to engage with participants
-  Taxi use limited opportunities to develop independent travel skills
-  Delays when families or support staff gave mixed messages/didn't engage
